

<u>Jan' Story</u> by Barry Petersen. Barry Petersen is a national news correspondent who has traveled the world doing stories for his work. Jan was his loving, vibrant wife. She was also a TV correspondent and a news anchor. Jan was diagnosed with early onset Alzheimer's Disease at age 55. This book is the author's love story to his wife, the long goodbye. It is the story of this couples "forever" which now came with an expiration date. It is the story of how this diagnosis impacted not only Jan but also Barry. Lisa Genova of the New York Times says about this book – "An intimate and courageously honest memoir about devastating loss, enduring love, and finding strength to carry on."

The library has quite a few books in the fiction section with an Amish theme. Two of these from the <u>Harvest of Hope</u> series by Barbara Cameron. Book 1 of this series is <u>Seeds of Hope</u>. Mark is a big city attorney, an "Englischer." His grandfather, John, has asked him to come back to Paradise, Pennsylvania to take over the family farm, to embrace the Amish side of this family's roots. Miriam is the young Amish girl who has always had a secret crush on Mark when he had come to his grandfather's farm for visits during his childhood. Is there a future for these two vastly different people? Book 2 is <u>Buried Secrets</u>. In this story, Rose's husband has died, and she returns to Paradise with her young son to be near her Amish family. Luke is ready to settle down in Paradise and forms a partnership with Rose to farm her land. Both Rose and Luke are hiding secrets which could interfere with their partnership and any chance that they could have of a future together.




