



Living Grace Library Mission December 2024



Christmas Books in the Library













As you come into the library, you will find Christmas books displayed on top of the bookshelves ready to be checked out and read including the following:

"<u>The Wish Book Christmas</u>" by Lynn Austin. It is 1951. Two single mothers, Eve Dawson and Audrey Barrett share a bungalow raising their five-year-old sons, Bobby & Harry. The boys discover the Sears Christmas Wish Book and want every toy in it (except the girl toys and the baby toys). The two moms realize that they need to help the boys realize that the true meaning of Christmas is more than just getting presents.

"Home for Christmas, Stories for Young and Old" compiled by Miriam LeBlanc and illustrated by David G. Klein. This book is a collection of twenty stories & essays by various authors including but not limited to Pearl Buck, Rebecca Caudill, Ruth Sawyer, Madeleine L'Engle and others. A quote from the back cover states "Selected for their literary quality and their spiritual integrity, they will resonate with readers of all ages, year after year.

"Christmas on Jane Street" This book is the tenth anniversary edition of a touching memoir by Billy Romp with Wanda Urbanska. Billy, his wife, Patti and three children live on a farm in Vermont. Every year the family comes to Jane Street in New York City beginning the day after Thanksgiving until Christmas Eve to sell their Christmas trees living in a small camper and becoming a part of the New York neighborhood for that month. This memoir is about a year in which Billy is especially worried about money and worried that he is losing touch with his daughter Ellie. Ellie has decided that what she wants for Christmas is for the family to go to the theatre to see The Nutcracker. Billy says that they cannot afford the tickets or take the night off from selling trees.

Grace Fall Bazaar Update

The Grace Fall Bazaar would like to thank everyone who contributed to this year's bazaar. Once again, the Grace congregation came forward using the gifts and talents Gad has given them. God truly blessed the day. At this time, the financial report shows receipts of \$16,116.05. There were 425 dozen cookies sold at Cookie Lane and 1131 pieces of lefse sold. 41 handmade quilts and approximately 150 lunches were sold. Our 10% donation to local charities was given to Mora food shelf, Food for Friends food shelf, Soup for the Soul, and the Good Samaritan Fund. A truly amazing number is the unofficial total revenues raised in 21 years of the Bazaar. That number is \$340,063.61. Praise Be to God! 10% of that total has been given to local charities and the rest has gone to programs, ministries, and property improvement here at Grace.


