NEW PATHWAYS... A MINISTRY FOR US??

Grace Lutheran was approached by a ministry organization that currently works with a dozen Lutheran churches in the area (Cambridge, North Branch, others) helping families who are in transition. The organization called New Pathways helps families who are seeking a new path in life and find themselves without a home and in need of support and structure. Churches rotate in providing a place for families to live for a week supplying lodging, meals and a sense of community and support. Families stay in the program for roughly 8 – 20 weeks. The church council of Grace has met with leadership from the organization including a leader in the church of Cambridge who works with Cambridge Lutheran to make this ministry happen.

I am looking for congregation members' feedback on people's willingness to lead this kind of ministry and our receptivity in supporting this ministry. We would be responsible for opening up rooms in the basement and setting up beds for those involved. We would also serve evening meals and have somebody spend the night to make sure all things run smooth. A big-time commitment? You bet. Before the next church council meeting, if you have thoughts, ideas, experience, or opinions on supporting this ministry, please talk with me. Maybe most important of all, would you be willing to take on key leadership to make this happen? I look forward to your response as we consider how to live out our Sunday morning proclamation, "We will go as spirit filled disciples of Jesus Christ."


LITTLE STEPS!!

We are teaming up with Calvary and Immanuel Brunswick for an awesome group of 25 youth and adults.






We are very close to meeting our goal for fundraising!! Thank you for all the support!!







Dear Jacob, A Mother's Journey of Hope by Patty Wetterling with Joy Baker. On October 22, 1989, 11-year-old Jacob Wetterling was kidnapped at gunpoint. For the next 27 years, his mother, Patty Wetterling focused on the hope that somehow, somewhere, Jacob had survived. Patty became a speaker and an advocate for missing and exploited children. This book is a story of a mother's strength and perseverance and so many years of not knowing and then in 2016 of finally knowing. The book ends with a letter to Jacob from his mom – "Jacob, because of you I learned so much along the way. I learned that each and every one of us has the capacity to do more than we ever dreamed....I learned that worry is useless......I learned that hope is a verb. It requires movement and doingI learned to not let the worst things in my life define me...I learned to pick myself up-over and over..."

Still Standing, The Story of SSG John Kriesel by John Kriesel as told to Jim Kosmo. On December 2, 2006, the vehicle that John Kriesel and four Army comrades were in was hit by an Improvised Explosive Devise in the desserts of Iraq. Two of his comrades lost their lives in this blast and John was severely injured losing both of his legs. This book is John's story beginning with joining the National Guard as a 17-year-old in Minnesota, life in the military and serving during the war in Iraq. It is the story of a man who was not expected to survive and then told he would probably be in a wheelchair the rest of his life to the man who was able to walk out of Walter Reed Army Medical Center on two prosthetic legs. It is the story of a man who has become a sought-after motivational speaker.

<u>Who Do I Lean on?</u> By Neta Jackson. This is book 3 on the YaDa YaDa House of Hope series found in the library. The books in this series center around the Manna House Homeless Shelter in Chicago. Gabby Fairbanks had been a wealthy wife living in a Chicago penthouse and found herself having to live at the shelter. In <u>Who Do I Lean On?</u>, an unexpected windfall allows Gabby to leave the shelter and live on her own in a six-plex property and she is able to have her two sons come back to live with her. When Gabby refuses to loan her estranged husband money to cover gambling debts, he makes desperate moves that put them all in danger. Gabby finds that she needs to lean on more than her own strength or the strength of her friends, that she needs to learn to lean on the only One who knows all things.



Thursday, May 9th, 2024 Ascension of Our Lord

Ascension of Our Lord, the fortieth day of Easter, thus always a Thursday. (May 9th, 2024), sometimes celebrated on the Sunday after Ascension Day.

What is the Ascension of Our Lord? Ascension Day marks not only the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, but his exaltation from servanthood to Ruler and Lord as the fitting climax of Resurrection Day.

Meaning: Ascension=Rising. We remember Jesus ascension into heaven and the promise to send the Spirit and be with us always.

Why Do You Stand Looking Up Toward Heaven?

We often cast our eyes upward to look for God. When we are feeling lonely or misunderstood, we raise our hands to ask why, or shake our fists in gestures of prayer, anguish, or praise. While the scriptures promise that God is king of all the earth, sitting on his holy throne (Psalm 47), we need not only look up for God's action in our lives. Our ascended Lord lives in the heavens, but Jesus does not leave his disciples—or us—to fumble while he naps in the clouds. Before he ascends, Jesus promises that we are clothed with the Holy Spirit's power, witnesses "to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8).

"Why do you stand looking up toward heaven?" the two men in white robes asked the witnesses remaining after Jesus ascended. Why do we stand still in our lives? Is it that we just saw God (Look! Up there! Did you see?), so we expect God to arrive in the same way again? Can God be that expected and predictable? This story of Jesus ascending to the heavens after his time with us on earth gives us mixed feelings: we know he's returning to where he belongs—out of this world full of brokenness and sin to holiness and glory. Still, our longing is intense: Lord, we want to see you! How will we know it is you when you come again?

Ascension Day could be explained as the cynical "I'm outta here" of a God weary of us self-centered, broken humans, but that explanation would be short-sighted because it leaves out the important stop on the cross. Instead, Jesus' departure is accompanied with the promise of the Spirit's presence remaining among us. We look up to the skies for help, then return our gaze to those among us in need of our care, to the body of Christ and the wind of the Spirit among the baptized, preparing for the time when Jesus comes again to gather us in.

Sunday May 19th, 2024 Wear Red for...

PENTECOST

Pentecost derives its name from the Jewish festival celebrating the harvest and the giving of the law on Mount Sinai fifty days after Passover. Fifty days after Easter, we celebrate the Holy Spirit as God's presence within and among us. In Acts the Spirit arrives in rushing wind and flame, bringing God's presence to all people. Paul reminds us that though we each have different capacities, we are unified in the Spirit that equips us with these gifts. Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit on his disciples, empowering them to forgive sin. We celebrate that we too are given the breath of the Holy Spirit and sent out to proclaim God's redeeming love to all the world.


