

New Books in the Library!

The library team has added some "new to the library" books to the library recently. Come into the library and check some out. The following three books are some of the new offerings.

Non-Fiction

It's Good to Be Queen, Becoming as Bold, Gracious, and Wise as the Queen of Sheba by Liz Curtis Higgs. (Section 7 in the non-fiction section of the library) According to the author of this book, the Queen of Sheba only appears in the Bible twice – one is I Kings, Chapter 10 with the same story retold in 2 Chronicles, Chapter 9. This wealthy queen travels a long distance with large caravan bringing gifts of gold, precious stones, and spices to seek out Solomon. She comes seeking wisdom and with hard questions for the wise King. Liz Curtis Higgs challenges the reader to be like the Queen of Sheba and to Be Bold, Good to Be Open, Good to Seek Wise Counsel, Good to Be Humbled, Good to Be Honest, Good to Encourage Others, Good to Praise Good, Good to Give Generously, Good to Receive Graciously and Good to End Well.

<u>The Greatest Gift, Unwrapping the Full Love Story of Christmas</u> by Ann Voskamp (Section 4 in the non-fiction section of the library). This book celebrates the lineage of God's gift to us of his Son in the Advent tradition of the Jesse Tree. The book contains a Bible reading and discussion for each day of Advent with questions for reflection on each reading. A quote from the author, "I don't want a Christmas you can buy. I don't want a Christmas you can make. What I want is a Christmas you can hold. A Christmas that holds me, remakes me, revives me. I want a Christmas that whispers, JESUS."

When We Meet Again by Kristina Harmel. Emily Emerson had just had her syndicated column cancelled for budgetary reasons. She is at a loss of what to do next, but she was used to being alone. Her father had left her and her mother when she was a young child, her mother had died when she was 18 and her grandmother had just died. So many secrets and things left unsaid. Emily has her own secrets. Then a mysterious painting arrived from Germany of a woman who looks like a younger version of her grandmother with a handwritten note that said, "He never stopped loving her." Emily begins to dig into her family story which leads her to a World War II POW internment camp in Florida and was surprised to learn that German prisoners were brought to America to work for American farmers. What did this have to do with Emily and the mystery painting?
