Lent 2024:

Holden Evening Prayer plus lessons for Mayberry

February brings the season of Lent, a spiritual time to reflect on who we are and what we value. On Wednesday February 14th (Valentine's Day) we will gather in the sanctuary to receive ashes on our forehead to remind ourselves that life is short and life is sacred. The next five weeks will be the Wednesday gatherings in the family life center for a meal and for a time of worship/reflection on renewal. Holden Evening prayer is part of the experience, songs of mediation and renewal. The teaching part of the night will include five weeks of stories from the Andy Griffith show; watching an episode and reflecting open the story line. I have come to see many of the stories from this series as parables, teaching moments about human sin and redemption. The lessons are not simply sweet moral lessons. When unpacked they can serve as a portal into the bigger means of life and the purpose of lent. Not to mention, they can be really fun. Mark your calendar for the journey of lent and the chance once again to gather around the word of God, fellowship with other Christian and the power to wait for the message of Easter.

It is the promise of new life.




Fiction

<u>A Flicker of Light</u> by Katie Powner. This story is set in a small mountain town in Montana called Moose Creek where everyone knows everyone and yet there are secrets still to be told. Bea's mom had died several years ago from cancer. Bea's dad Mitch & Bea have lost their connection to each other. Bea went away to college and got married to a "city" boy and got pregnant. Jobless and broke, the young couple moved back in with Bea's dad in Moose Creek. Pastor Frank & Mitch have always been friends, but Mitch has stopped going to church since his wife died. Grandma Rose has secrets of her own but is slipping away with early onset dementia. And yet if you know where to look, the flicker of light shows up over the mountain at just the right time.

<u>The Woman from Lydia</u> by Angela Hunt. This story is set in Biblical times. The widow Euodia, also known as the woman from Lydia, has settled in the foreign city of Philippi where she had encountered the apostle to the Gentiles, Paulos. A retired Roman soldier, Hector, has also settled in Phillippi with dreams of acquiring wealth and status partly with the use of a young slave girl who can foretell the future. Paulos has removed this demon from the young girl. Hector begins to travel the world to find someone who can restore this "gift" to his slave girl. Euodia and her servants follow Hector on this journey to rescue the young girl.

<u>The Great Alone</u> by Kristin Hannah. This story is set in Alaska and is divided into three sections, 1974, 1978 and 1986. A family in crisis, including a former Viet Nam POW, Ernt Allbright, his wife, Cora, and his daughter, Leni, find their way to a wild, remote area of Alaska to start a new life "off the grid." The family is unprepared for this life, but the locals' step in to help. Even so, the long, dark winter is too much for Ernt's fragile metal state. This is a compelling story of survival in the most trying circumstances.

Come in and explore the church library – Lots of good reading awaits. Living Grace Library is open whenever the church is open. Come in anytime.




On Ash Wednesday, February 14th, 2024, we begin our forty-day journey toward Easter with a day of fasting and repentance. Marking our foreheads with dust, we acknowledge that we die and return to the earth. At the same time, the dust traces the life-giving cross indelibly marked on our foreheads at baptism. While we journey through Lent to return to God, we have already been reconciled to God through Christ. We humbly pray for God to make our hearts clean while we rejoice that "now is the day of salvation." Returning to our baptismal call, we more intentionally bear the fruits of mercy and justice in the world.

Let the Children Come

The cross-shaped smear of ashes we impose on our foreheads this holy day is, for many Christians, one of the few times each year when we wear a publicly visible sign of our religious identity. Children notice how neighbors of other faiths—whether they live on the same block, share a classroom, or show up on television—daily bear outward expressions of their faith through wardrobe, diet, or prayer practices. The dusty cross we wear today expresses something that is true every day:

we are beloved children of God who are joined to the love of Jesus in life and in death.


